How to apply

Eligible candidates need to complete:

1. Scholarship application form available from admissions@verdala.org
2. Application letter explaining
 - (a) their experience as a migrant
 - (b) an example of a learning experience
 - (c) their goals for the future
3. Documentation demonstrating refugee/migrant status.
4. A reference letter eg. from a current Principal/Community Leader.

*Candidates must send/bring in all documentation by March 22, 2019 to admissions@verdala.org

*All suitable candidates will be interviewed during April 2019.

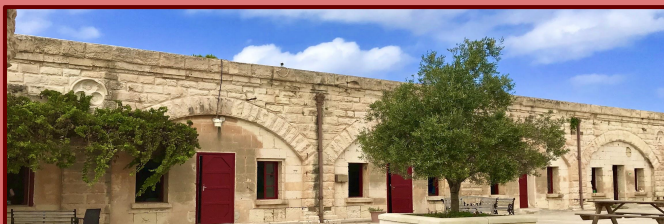

The Scholarship

The two (or 3) year scholarship shall be awarded as a 100% grant paid to VIS which will include:

- all academic fees
- school lunch
- examination fees
- after school activities
- field trips



Criteria for this Scholarship

- Sixth-form Student (DP programme) or pre-Sixth-form (includes 1 prep year before DP).
- Age 15+
- Student is means-tested and has proof of migrant status.
- Academically strong enough to cope with rigour of the programme (assessed through essay, interview and school entrance assessment).
- Fluent in English (English medium programme).



VISFund Principal Objective

Purpose of the VISFund is the advancement of education for persons living in Malta whose status is one of the following:

- Legally recognised refugee(s) and asylum seekers (as per Geneva convention and Maltese European legislation)
- Persons who are granted a Specific Residence Authorisation
- THP holders or
- THPN holders
